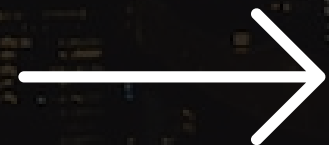


Anti-Social Engineering

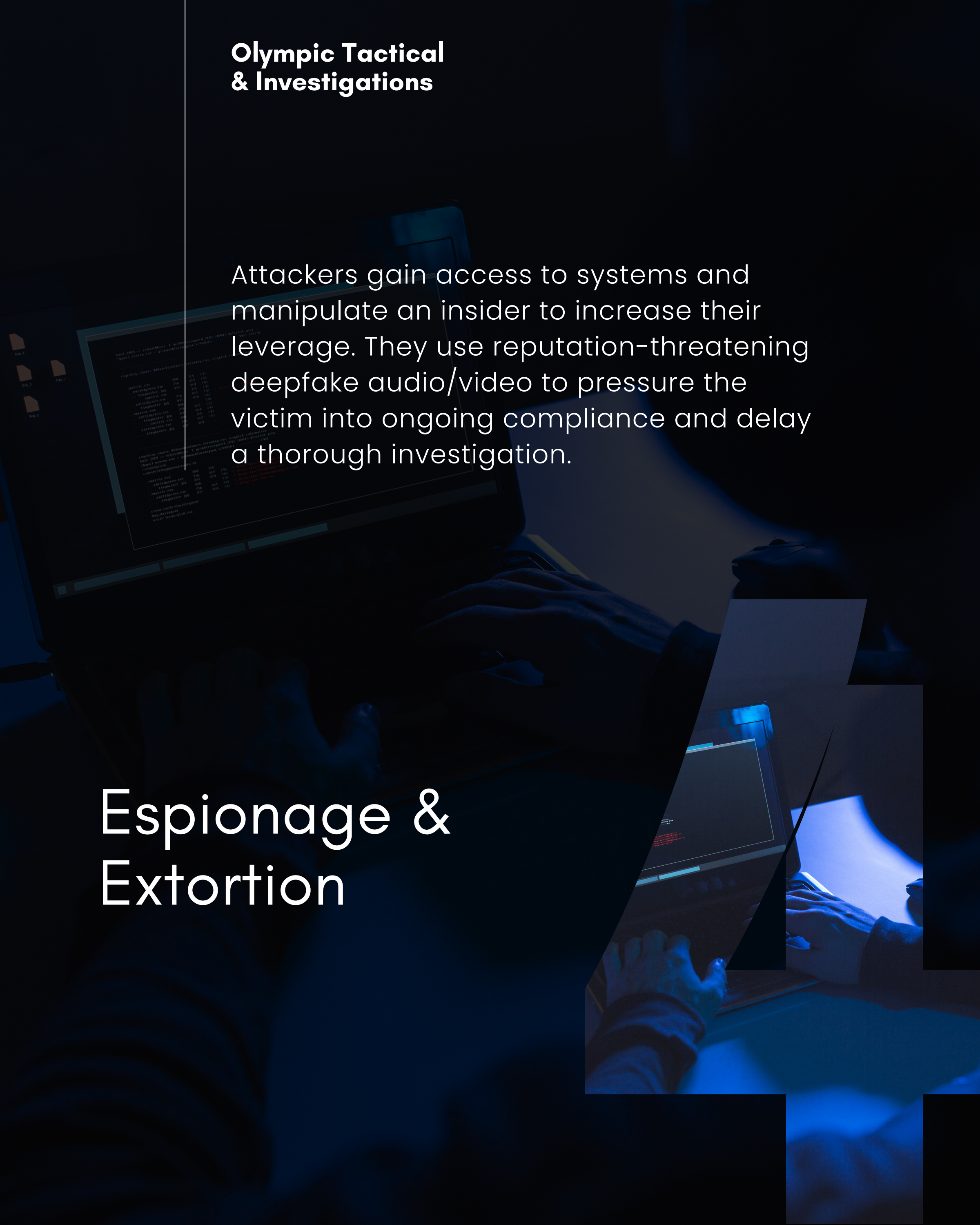
